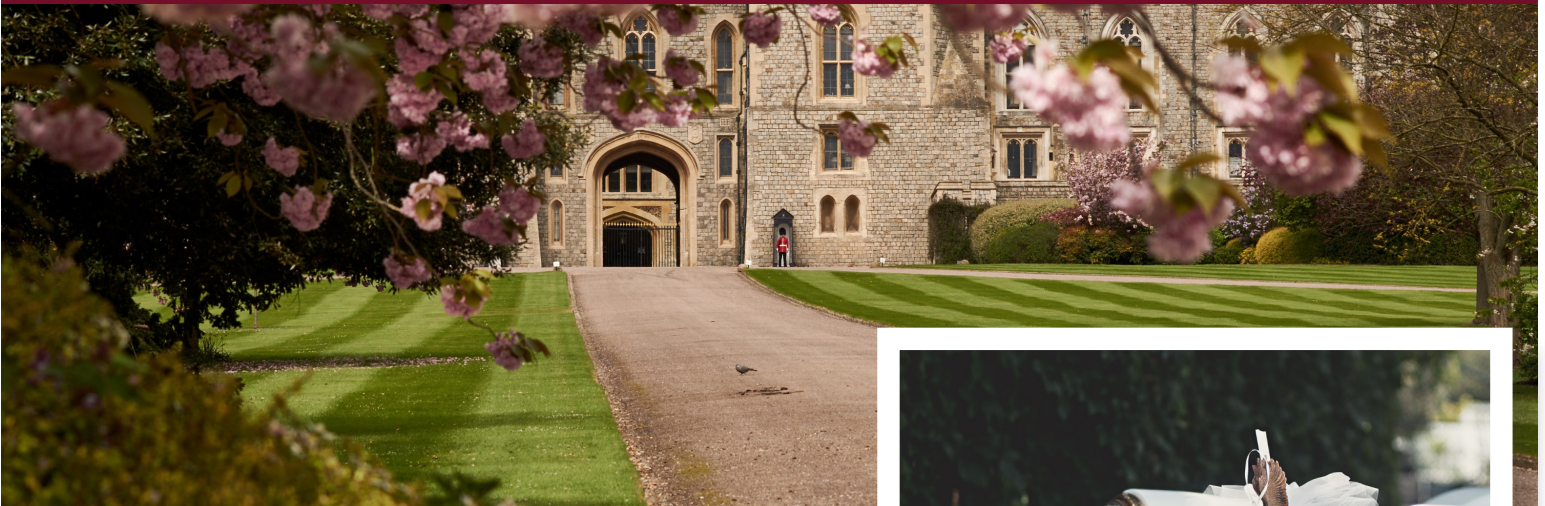

**MONDAY, MAY 14<sup>TH</sup>** - Departure from your chosen US gateway city. **OVERNIGHT: PLANE**

**TUESDAY, MAY 15<sup>TH</sup>** - Upon arrival at either of London's airports, you will be met and transported to your hotel in London - the prestigious private members' club, The Sloane Club. Here, we enjoy a welcome buffet lunch with founder of The English Manner, Alexandra Messervy, formerly of the Royal Household of Her Majesty The Queen. Learn some secrets behind planning such historic events, and begin a series of discussions about etiquette, style, traditions and weddings of the British Royal Family. We will be met by Lord Maurice Fermoy, cousin to Princess Diana and Prince Harry and former Royal Page to Her Majesty The Queen and Yevnig Davis, who has been commissioned for several Royal and VIP celebration creations. Yevnig will talk about her designs and guests will be able to sample some of her secret recipes. After lunch, we depart for a private tour with the Director of the Household Cavalry Museum, an inspection of the Garrison accompanied by the Director and the daily parade on Horseguards with Lord Fermoy, former fellow officer of Prince Harry in the Blues and Royals Household Cavalry. Afterwards, we have a unique opportunity to watch the horses feeding time! This evening is free for guests to dine at leisure, perhaps enjoying the informal bar of the Sloane Club or the award-winning dining room. Alternatively, there is a fabulous choice of local restaurants, from the authentic Parisian style brasserie Colbert, to the delicious, seafood orientated, Italian Caraffini, just over the road. If you decide to venture out, you'll have the opportunity to browse local shops and restaurants bedecked with Royal Wedding themed windows. **(L) OVERNIGHT: THE SLOANE CLUB**

**WEDNESDAY, MAY 16<sup>TH</sup>** - Departing after an early breakfast, we will have a very unique opportunity to visit Princess Diana's favorite couture designer, the Atelier of the late Catherine Walker, for an exclusive talk and private viewing. Closed to the general public, this very special part of our programme will be subject to availability. HRH The Duchess of Cornwall and other members of the Royal Family are likely to have outfits made for the wedding here and may need final fittings or alterations. In the event that we cannot visit, we will make a special arrangement with the Royal milliner or another Royal designer of note. We then



visit the lifelong home of Prince Harry, Kensington Palace, touring the State Apartments and Royal exhibitions. A new exciting exhibition opens in March 2018; *Victoria Revealed*, which will showcase hundreds of items, documents and historical facts about the life of Queen Victoria, who came to the throne aged just 18 in 1837. Guests are able to take refreshments or lunch in the cafe on-site. Our afternoon ends with a visit to the Royal Gardens with Todd Longstaffe-Gowan, Royal Gardens Historian and Consultant, followed by a traditional Royal Afternoon Tea at the Milestone Hotel. **(B, T) OVERNIGHT: THE SLOANE CLUB**



**THURSDAY, MAY 17<sup>TH</sup>** - This morning, we depart by coach for Stonor Park hosted by William Stonor. Stonor is the family home of Lord Camoys, former Lord Chamberlain to Her Majesty The Queen. The Lord Chamberlain is the most senior of the Royal Courtiers. It is his responsibility to oversee every detail of ceremonial occasions, such as the Royal Wedding, as well as day-to-day operations of the Royal household. Stonor Park is one of the very few houses in England which has remained in the ownership of the same family from the earliest records to the present day. Buildings at this special property date from the 12<sup>th</sup>

century and are nestled in a fold of the Chiltern hills amongst breathtaking views. Old Master drawings, family portraits and Renaissance tapestries jostle for space, along with a rare collection of furniture and modern ceramics. A Catholic stronghold, Mass has been celebrated in the chapel of Stonor Park since medieval times. We will take lunch here before we drive to Henley on Thames, home of the Royal Yacht Regatta for Tea at Phyllis Court with the Contessa Angela Postiglione, who will discuss the Royal Wedding guest list. On our way back to London, we drive through Windsor and the veritable frenzy of excitement at the celebrations to come. We return to the hotel for a free evening. **(B, L, T) OVERNIGHT: THE SLOANE CLUB**

**FRIDAY, MAY 18<sup>TH</sup>** - Departing after an early breakfast, we drive to the Tower of London for an exclusive private view and morning tour of the Crown Jewels, followed by a visit to Banqueting House, the only remaining component of the Royal Palace of Whitehall. We end our morning with a visit to Royal St. James's and a selection of Royal Warrant Holders, and will be joined by our delightful tutors, Emma Lane & William Hanson. William is often called upon by the media to commentate about etiquette matters and Royal events. The two elegance experts will guide guests around some favorite shops of the younger Royals,





and a few traditional favorites of The Queen. This afternoon, we enjoy a private view of the beautifully restored Georgian gem, Spencer House, former family home of Diana, Princess of Wales, with head guide and friend of The English Manner, Ros Hutchinson. Returning to the Sloane Club for an early evening drinks reception, we will be joined by Royal milliner, Vivien Sherriff, who has created many hats for The Duchess of Cambridge and younger members of the Royal Family. Vivien and Emma will chat about how to make the most of formal dress styles, and how to wear a hat, over a glass of champagne. We are then joined by leading society florist, Judith Blacklock, for a conversation about Royal flowers and creating special occasion designs for weddings and parties. Judith is a well known commentator on floral design worldwide and worked with Fox News during the Marriage of Prince William of Wales in 2011, discussing live the choice of blooms and designs of the bouquets

and decorations. Her predictions of live trees were spot on!

**SATURDAY, MAY 19<sup>TH</sup>** - Today is Royal Wedding Day! We have a special day planned, with details subject to the special timing of the day's events. We begin with a champagne brunch with Royal proceeding commentary and special guests. Such substitutions do not constitute grounds for withdrawal with full refund.
6. Conduct During The Tour: You are also responsible for respecting the authority and following the directions of the tour guide and the laws of the countries in your itinerary. We may exclude you from participating in all or any part of the tour if, in our sole discretion, your condition or behavior renders you unfit for the tour or unfit for continuation once the tour has begun. Unfitness may include, without limitation, any behavior that, regardless of its cause, is inappropriate or offensive or interferes with the delivery of our services, or may constitute a hazard or embarrassment. In such case, our liability shall be strictly limited to refund of the recoverable cost of any unused portion of the tour. Should you decide not to participate in certain parts of the tour or use certain goods included in the tour, no refunds will be made for those unused parts of the tour or goods.

**TOUR COST ADJUSTMENTS**

Discover Europe makes every effort to guarantee that the published cost of your chosen tour will not change. However, we do reserve the right to make adjustments in the following circumstances:



1. Exchange rates. Should the value of the dollar fall against the currency of the countries visited on your tour by more than 10% in the 6 months prior to trip departure.
2. Group size. Your tour has been based on a minimum group size of 8 participants. Should we end up with fewer than 8 people, Discover Europe will work with The English Manner to determine a course of action which may involve either paying a surcharge to keep the tour with all the inclusions listed, or making adjustments in order to keep the cost the same.
3. Airfares. If your tour includes airfare, Discover Europe reserves the right to pass along increases in costs (taxes, airport fees, fuel surcharges, etc.) that are charged by the airline involved.

**REFUND POLICY**

1. Participants who withdraw more than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$200 cancellation penalty.
2. Participants who withdraw fewer than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less the following cancellation penalties:  
     90-61 days prior to departure: \$1000 per person  
     60 - 31 days prior to departure: \$2000 per person  
     Fewer than 30 days prior to departure: no refund
3. Please note that the final payment becomes due upon receipt of the final invoice and will remain payable, as per the above schedule, if your cancellation is received after this.
4. These cancellation penalty amounts do not include any airfares purchased on your behalf by Discover Europe Ltd. Note that the least expensive airfares are usually non-refundable. Refunds for airline tickets will be handled separately from the refund of the land tour package.
